10	12	<i>Administration has done excellent job with [creating student agenda]. Conversely, the agenda could be more personalized by adding history about Eagle Lake First Nation. Additional suggestions would include: A list of all the chiefs in Eagle Lake, History of the treaty #3 Territory and/or important land claims in the territory, present and past role models in the school, etc.</i>
10	15	<i>Dramatic Arts may include the following activities:</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Reader's Theatre;</i> • <i>Theatresports;</i> • <i>Text Studies: Oxymorons;</i> • <i>Text Studies: Lists; and</i> • <i>Speaking, Reading and Emotional Intelligence, etc.</i>
9	43	<i>Migisi Sahgaigan School policy needs to be updated. The Elementary School's policy should be separated from the policy of High School Students. There had been some important amendments added to the policy but needs to flow together. It is advisable to separate policies for Chief and Council and procedures for the school. In this way, administrations can make appropriate changes to procedures; whereas, policies are concrete according to Chief and Council.</i>
8	1	<i>It is recommended that the School Council members participate in board training so they can run the business side of school in the most professional and efficient manner.</i>
8	40	<i>Administration should continue to look at teacher training strategically by building capacity within the school to ensure teacher lead position include:</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Reading Specialists</i> • <i>Writing Specialists</i> • <i>Math Specialists</i> • <i>Special Education Specialists</i> • <i>Ojibwe Language Instruction</i>
7	6	<i>It is recommended and mandatory that the Migisi Sahgaigan School set up it's own Health and Safety Committee within the school to discuss any issues related to any hazards for students and staff. This committee will require training. The committee members will learn to conduct evaluations, site evaluations, site evaluations, site safety and fire inspections.</i>
7	11	<i>Engaging the parents in school is an important piece to build relationships with families. A Parent Involvement Committee would be an asset for Migisi Sahgaigan School. In this way, parents could contribute to directly supporting the school and student success. A Parent Involvement Committee makes parent engagement a priority by providing direction for the school and providing discussion between the School Board and community members.</i>
7	14	<i>Other teaching methodologies to implement or try could include the following:</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Experiential learning;</i> • <i>Personalized reflection;</i> • <i>Independent study.</i>
7	20	<i>The education staff might want to look into "Strength-Based Approaches" which support learners to look at their unique abilities and strengths rather than fixing "what's wrong". This approach assists students to "make the behaviour changes" they need to make to be responsible learners.</i>
